Our aim is to make music accessible to all through a vibrant, positive musical community, where everyone's voice can be heard, and where people feel empowered in musical creativity and activities, ensuring all are continually welcomed and included.

We enable this through our community musical instrument library (currently over 1800 items), workshops, tuition, events and our members and partner organisations support. We currently have over 300 members and work with 20 partner organisations across Scotland. We are Glasgow based but provide Scotland wide support.

We are looking for individuals who can put their skills, knowledge and experience to use to the benefit of our Music Broth board and organisation, and who have the capacity, potential and commitment in the role, or supported to 'grow' into the role.

Our trustees generally meet every two months to discuss various issues; our organisational strategy and development, support for our members, tutors and volunteers, training, events, workshop programmes, and finances. Meetings last around 2 hours. Trustees occasionally form sub groups or provide support to individual team members or volunteers to look at specific issues. These activities generally last only a couple of months to support upcoming board meetings as appropriate.
